



Terms and Conditions:

REFUNDS: Students that withdraw from the Driver Education program prior to completion are entitled to a prorated refund according to the following schedule:

Withdrawal prior to the start of class = 100%

Withdrawal after the start of class = 15% of fees paid divided by 30 hours for each hour of classroom not completed; 85% of fees paid divided by 6 hours for each hour of behind the wheel instruction not completed.

Refunds will be forwarded to the address of record within 15 days of the date that written notification of withdrawal is made. In addition to the monetary refund, students will receive documentation of any training that was completed on the appropriate Motor Vehicle Administration provided forms.

Classroom education must be completed within 6 months of first class. All behind the wheel instruction must be scheduled and completed within 18 months of first day of classroom education. For the safety of our new drivers, if Driver's Education is not completed within the 24 months mentioned above, the student must re-take the entire driver education program and pay the required fees associated with a new student.

No behind the wheel driving lessons can be scheduled until the student has completed all of their required classroom education.

Prior to attending Day 10 and taking final exam, the entire education course must be paid in full.

If a student misses more than 4 days of their scheduled 10 day classroom driver education program, the student must restart the course from the beginning of the program. Students will then have 60 days to restart or all monies paid will be forfeited.
