



Terms and Conditions

We reserve the right to change our teaching schedule. Students may not leave the building and re-enter during class. Refunds are not offered for any services. Returned check fee is \$25.00.

For ALL classroom sessions: driving instruction is highly regulated by the CT DMV, therefore, **lateness cannot be tolerated, and the door will be locked 5-minutes after the class is scheduled to start, with no admittance thereafter.** A ten-minute break is given in each class.

Driving instruction needs to be taken seriously; therefore disruptive behavior and/or property damage will not be tolerated. If any disruption or damage occurs, it will result in expulsion from the class, and no refunds will be granted. Additionally, the student or the student's parent will be fully and solely responsible for any and all damage done willfully.

For safety purposes, video surveillance of the entire premises is in effect.

As a student (or parent of a student), by enrolling in our school you are giving us implied consent to use your likeness or comments in any marketing or promotion for the school including, but not limited to, advertisements, websites and mailings.

Behind-The-Wheel Instruction:

1. Students must have a valid Connecticut learners' permit and have it present during the driving lesson(s).
2. Cancellations must be made more than 24-hours in advance of the scheduled drive lesson by the student/parent/guardian.
3. High Ridge Driving School has a \$25 no-permit lesson cancellation and a \$70 no-show policy to cover the costs associated with your missed lesson.
4. Driver training is available 7-days a week, student must sign up for lessons in advance.

A student without a valid CT learner's permit or driver's license, being impaired for any reason (lack of sleep, intoxication, medication, etc.), or wearing footwear which may impair the ability to safely operate the vehicle, will result in the lesson being cancelled and considered a no-show, therefore a no-show fee will be applied.

Full Teen Course

A textbook and workbook are given to each student. In order to be eligible to receive a Full Teen Course certificate you must complete the following:

- 30 hours of classroom attendance
 - 22 hours of classroom instruction
 - 8-Hour Drug & Alcohol class
 - Parent attendance for Parent Class (under 18 only)
- 8 hours of in-car driver training
- Billing account current

8-Hour Drug & Alcohol Class

Separate classes are offered for adults (Adult Class) and students who are 16 and 17 years old (Teen Class).

Classes are taught in two (2) four-hour classes (named "1" and "2"). Attendance at both classes is required (classes can be taken in either order) plus a satisfactory grade on the test.

All classes are held at our location.
