To get a Washington State driver license, applicants are required to pass a knowledge and driving test. *Munros' Driving Instruction, Inc.* is authorized by the Department of Licensing to provide both the knowledge and driving tests. In order to test with us, applicants must either visit a Department of Licensing office to provide the necessary documents or pre-apply online at <a href="http://www.dol.wa.gov/driverslicense/preapply.html">http://www.dol.wa.gov/driverslicense/preapply.html</a>.

Scores for the knowledge and driving test will be reported to the Department of Licensing electronically within 24 hours. Passing the knowledge and driving test **does not** guarantee that an applicant will be issued a driver license. The Department of Licensing will determine if an applicant has met all licensing requirements. The Department of Licensing reserves the right to retest applicants who complete tests through Munros' Driving Instruction. Retesting is done at random and at no cost to the applicant.

### Knowledge Test

The knowledge test consists of 25 multiple-choice questions about traffic safety laws. Applicants must answer at least 20 questions correctly in order to pass the test. The knowledge test will be offered at specific times at select locations. For more information and to reserve your slot, please call our office at 1-800-437-4834 or enroll online.

#### **Driving Test**

The driving test will test applicants' ability to drive legally and safely. Applicants must pass the driving test with a score of 80 or better out of 100 possible points. For more information on what applicants will be evaluated on, please

#### **Vehicles for Testing**

Applicants may provide their own vehicles or rent one of our vehicles to use for the driving test. Our cars are small to midsize sedans with automatic transmissions. Applicants are encouraged to schedule a practice session prior to the test to become comfortable with the operation of the vehicle (there is a fee –see p.2) The following requirements MUST be met if applicants elect to use their own vehicles for the driving test:

- All brakes lights must work
- All turn signals must work
- Seat belts must function and be used
- License plates must be on front and back of vehicle with current tabs on rear plate
- Windshield must not be not cracked or chipped in the line of vision
- If raining, windshield wipers must function and the defroster system must work properly to defog the windows
- Tires must meet state requirements for tire tread (no bald tires)
- A valid insurance card must be presented at the time of testing (examiner may verify insurance with carrier)

#### **TERMS & CONDITIONS:**

Munros' Driving reserves the right to refuse service; in that case you may will need to test at another driving school or at the DOL. If you need a special service such as testing in a foreign language or require special assistance, the DOL requires that you take the test with them. Exact cash is only accepted if you are doing a WRITTEN test. We require pre-payment for the DRIVE test, preferably in the form of credit or debit card.

**CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY:** If you do not show up for your drive test appointment and/or provide less than a 24 hour notice to cancel, there is **NO** refund. You must pre-pay in order to reschedule the test. If you cancel no less than 24 hours or more notice, then we will refund your payment less a \$5 credit card processing fee.
